Getting to the hotel from the airport:

*When reading this page, please refer to Image: 1 on your right.

You will start from Customs. Make your way to DSB and purchase your ticket.

*Please note: The machines only accept coins and all major credit cards. When asked where you will be going, choose Kongens Nytorv (3 zones). Please keep your printed ticket (and receipt).

Next, make your way to Up to Metro. You will take an escalator to the next floor and continue walking straight until the hall ends. Where the hall ends is where the metros are. You do not need to pay attention to which one you get on because there is only one line that goes to the airport (M2). Once you are on the metro get off at Kongens Nytorv.

Image: 2 (below) is a visual of the metro lines. You will be on M2, getting on from Lufthavnen Copenhagen Airport, and getting off at Kongens Nytorv.



The Copenhagen Metro has two lines which run from suburban Vanløse to Vestamager and Copenhagen Airport, both situated on the island of Amager. The Metro runs 24 hours a day, every day of the week.

Once you have stepped off the metro at Kongens Nytory, follow the exit signs.

Image 3 shows a general overview from Kongens Nytorv to the Admiral Hotel.

Once you have exited the Metro, notice Magasin Du Nord, the large department store.

With Magasin to your back, cross the two double lane streets. Watch out for bicyclists, they also have their own lane.


Once you have made it across the street safely, take a left.

Follow the path of the dotted blue lines on **Image 3**. You will see the famous colored houses along the harbor (this is called Nyhavn).

Once you have come to Nyhavn, you will notice a slight fork in the road. Make sure you go down the road named, "Store Strandstræde".

Continue onto Store Strandstræde,

Once you have come to the end of Store Strandstæde, turn right onto Sankt Annæ Pl.

Once the green in the middle of the streets has finished, take a left (see image 6).

Once you have taken that left, continue straight onto Toldbodgade.

The Admiral Hotel will be on your right hand side.

Meals:

Breakfast is provided at the hotel on 25th,26th, and 27th. You will also get lunch all three days of the workshop. The two dinners will be at DTU and a Maritime Museum in Helsingør. More information to follow.

Evening of the 24th:

The welcome reception will take place at the Admiral Hotel at 19:00. Please ask the desk when you arrive where it will exactly be. Food and drinks will be served from 19:00-20:30.

On the 25th:

Busses will come to pick up you up at 07:50 outside of the Admiral Hotel. Please be outside a few minutes before. You will be driven to building 101 at the Technical University of Denmark. Please enter the building. You will find signs telling you where to go.

When the workshop ends, you will be given the opportunity to sign up and take tours of the laboratories or DTU Brewery. After, a buffet dinner will be served. The bus will then take you back to the Admiral Hotel at 20:00

On the 26th:

The bus will pick you up at 08:00, please be outside a few minutes before. You will be dropped off at the same location at the DTU campus. A tentative program can be found on the following pages.

When the workshop ends, the busses will come to pick you up at 16:45 and drive you to the Maritime Museum (Museet for Søfart) for the final dinner.

Dinner on the 26th: Dinner will be at the Maritime Museum. The busses should arrive at 17:30. We will enter the museum, deliver our jackets, and make our way through part of the museum and into a large auditorium. Here, a 20 minute talk will be given.





After, a dinner will be served followed by coffee. The dinner will be three courses with snacks and petit-fours. Wine, beer, and sodas will also be served.

Once the sit-down dinner is done, everyone will make their way down some stairs to the café area where coffee will be served. Here, you can also buy additional drinks at your own expense. The bus will arrive at 22:00 to drive everyone back to the Admiral Hotel.

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On the 27th:

The busses will pick you up at 08:15 at the same location as the days before. Again, be outside a few minutes before. Please bring your luggage with you, as you will not be returning to the hotel.

When the workshop ends, the busses will pick you up at 13:00 and drive you directly to the airport. The estimated arrival time to the airport is 13:40-13:55 depending on traffic.
