

EURL-FV Workshop 2014 for Pesticide Residues in fruits and vegetables

The EURL-FV is pleased to invite the National Reference Laboratories for Fruits and Vegetables to the EURL-FV Workshop 2014. The workshop will be held in Almería, Spain, 11-12 September 2014 at the Hotel Barceló Cabo de Gata (Retamar, Almería-SPAIN).

Reimbursement to NRLs will be made following the European Union rules, for travel costs, hotel costs and daily allowance for <u>one</u> <u>participant per NRL and a maximum of 1 participant per country</u>. Please, inform us as soon as possible of the selected eligible participant in order to get acceptable flight ticket costs.

For registration, there is a Form named **'Eligible Application Form'** that can be downloaded from the EURL-FV web site (www.eurl-pesticides.eu). The deadline to apply is the 23rd of June 2014.

In order to facilitate your travel, the EURL-FV will assume directly the cost of the hotel booking and the flight tickets for those eligible participants. Please fill in the form with your data and your preferences and we will book everything for you through our travel agency.

There will be approximately 20 extra vacancies for other members of NRLs or official laboratory participants that would like to attend being **non-eligible participants**. Those participants will have to pay 250 Euros that will cover coffees, meals and conference attendance. They have to register through another Application Form, named **'Non-eligible Application Form'** in the website. <u>Please</u> <u>be aware that there is no more availability for further participants</u>.

Non-eligible participants will have to book by themselves.

The programme will be published in July and will to cover the following topics:

- EUPTs-FV
- NRL experiences on quantification strategies
- Stability of analytical standards, current approaches, benefits and drawbacks
- How to deal with difficult matrices? Current strategies and results from EUPTs
- HRMS for pesticide analysis
- Problematic compounds in MRM (captan, folpet, dicofol, etc)
