

# 3rd Joint Workshop of the EURLs, NRLs and OFLs for Pesticide Residues in Food and Feed

Freiburg, Germany, 27 - 28 September, 2011

## Excerpt of Technical Report

### 1. Summary

The Joint Workshop of the European Union Reference Laboratories for Pesticide Residues in Fruits and Vegetables (EURL-FV), Cereals and Feedingstuffs (EURL-CF), Food of Animal Origin (EURL-AO) and Single Residue Methods (EURL-SRM) was organized by the EURL-AO and was held on 27-28 September 2011 in Freiburg (Germany). All National Reference Laboratories (NRLs) and Official Laboratories (OfLs) providing data for the EU-coordinated control programme were invited to participate. In total, 139 representatives from the Commission and 31 different countries participated including scientists from all NRLs of the 27 EU Member States, furthermore OfLs from Member States as well as NRLs or OfLs from Norway, Switzerland, Serbia and Turkey.

The two-day workshop covered a comprehensive scientific programme:

- The representative of the Commission informed on the latest activities on the EU-coordinated control programme.
- All EURLs presented the results of their recent proficiency tests (EUPTs) and the current status of the joint EUPT archive project. Then, the outcome of the EUPTs and possible conclusions and solutions for analytical improvements were discussed in detail with the participants in two parallel sessions (one session with networks of EURL-FV and EURL-SM; another session with networks of EURL-CF, EURL-SRM and EURL-AO).
- The proposed changes of the AQC document (SANCO 10684/2009) were presented by the coordinator and members of the advisory board and intensely discussed before voting (one vote per Member State). As a result, 25 Member States agreed to the proposed amendments whereas Belgium and Portugal raised objections. This concern will be addressed in following discussions with the advisory board and the competent committees at EU level.
- 6 invited speakers presented different topics of pesticide residue analysis.
- All EURLs presented their work programmes for 2012.
- The next joint workshop will be held in 2013 in Almeria (Spain) and will be organized by EURL-FV.
