

Introduction

On behalf of the Organising Committee, we are pleased to invite the EU National Reference Laboratories (EU-NRL) and the official laboratories (OFLs) on Pesticide Residues from EU member states, EU candidate states and EFTA countries to attend the 2011 JOINT WORKSHOP of the EU-REFERENCE LABORATORIES FOR PESTICIDE RESIDUES (EURL). The workshop will be held in Freiburg (Germany) from 27-28 September 2011.

Workshop concept and consequences for limitation of number of participants

The concept is orientated in organization rather of a workshop than of a conference: We developed a concept with partly parallel sessions for discussion of the EU-PTs and a poster session allowing also some time for direct exchange of experience between participants. Furthermore, the presentation, discussion and voting of the planned modifications of the QC document can be better performed in a workshop atmosphere than in a conference.

Therefore, we need to limit the number of participants of the networks of the four pesticide EURLs to 200. The concept comprises up to 120 participants from COM/EURLs/NRLs (as eligible participants, with up to three eligible participants from EU-NRLs per EU Member States) and possibly more participants at costs of the respective institute. Participation of non-eligible participants from NRLs and OFLs will be limited within the maximum possible number on a first come - first served basis.

Registration Fee

The registration fee covers the participation in the workshop, coffee in breaks and lunches at the workshop and the participation in the Welcome Reception on Monday, 26 September 2011, and the conference dinner on Tuesday, 27 September 2011.

1. Fee for eligible members of EU National Reference Laboratories for Pesticide Residues

Participation for eligible members of EU-NRLs for pesticide residues is free of charge. Up to three participants from EU-NRLs for pesticide residues per EU Member State will be eligible for reimbursement (participation in the same number of 2011 EUPTs is mandatory for eligibility).

2. Fee for non-eligible participants

Registration before 1 July 2011: €250 Registration after 1 July 2011: €300

After registration an invoice will be sent to non-eligible participants.
